Up until the mid 1950s wiring in electronic equipment was point to point. Color coded wiring was used to some extent and when you could not wire components to a tube socket pin you used terminal strips. Terminal strips were made with two up to eight or ten terminals and you wired the various components, resistors, capacities, diodes and other components into the circuits. After the 50s printed circuit boards took the place of the point to point wiring. At the February meeting our Steve Jackson will provide the group with a discussion about constructing printed circuit boards. He will tell us how to make our own PC boards in your home work shop.
